**OBITUARY.**

The funeral took place at Dawlish on Wednesday last of the late Mr Ernest Ager, who was for some years chauffeur at Luscombe Castle. Deceased was a victim of the war. He contracted tuberculosis whilst on service. Sanatorium treatment failed to affect a cure, and after a long illness, borne with much fortitude, he passed away at the Devon and Exeter Hospital on the 5th inst., at the age of 41.
