Private Herbert Arthur Garrett 7th October 1917

The death has taken place from dysentery in East Africa of Pte H A Garrett, M.T., A.S.C., only child of Mr and Mrs Herbert Garrett, of Teignmouth and Holcombe. It will be remembered that before the late Pte Garrett went on service his case came before the Dawlish Tribunal on three or four occasions, his father strongly appealing for his exemption on account of the amount of ground cultivated and his dependence upon his son for its proper upkeep. It is extremely sad that young Garrett should have succumbed to disease so soon after his departure on active service.
