

Sergeant Henry John Harris

26th August 1918

We deeply regret to have to record the death of another Dawlish soldier on active service, viz., Sergt Henry Harris, of the Devons, eldest son of Mr and Mrs Harris, of Shiverstone Cottages. Deceased was a regular soldier and was in Egypt when war broke out, subsequently removing with his battallion to France. He had seen much active service. He died on the 26th August at a casualty clearing station in France from a gunshot wound in the right thigh. Only 11 days had passed since deceased was home on leave.
