News has just been received by Mrs. Harris, 66, Clifton-street, Newtown, Exeter, of the death of her husband, Pte. Percy Harris, of the 11th Batt. East Lancashire Regt. The sad news was conveyed in most sympathetic letters from deceased's C.O. and Chaplain, saying he was killed in action during an enemy raid by a machine-gun bullet, and was buried in a British cemetery behind the lines. Deceased was much respected by all who knew him.
