Frank Brook 30th June 1920

Dawlish Gazette – 10th July 1920

The funeral took place on Saturday last of the late Mr Frank Brook (formerly of the Royal Navy), of Shiverstone, who passed peacefully away at Ivy Bank on June 30th after a long and painful illness.
