

Alfred Samuel Baron - 13th May 1915

Mrs Baron, wife of one of the Dawlish Coastguards, who was on H.M.S. Goliath, received a telegram from the Admiralty on Tuesday morning stating that her husband was not among the list of survivors. Much sympathy is felt with the widow and the three fatherless children, the youngest of whom is only three months old. Mrs Baron was a Miss Ewings. Her father was a naval pensioner, and the family resided in Dawlish for many years. Besides Cheif Officer Pursloe, who is unfit for active service, there were only two coastguards stationed at Dawlish when the war broke out. Both have now fallen in the service of their country.
